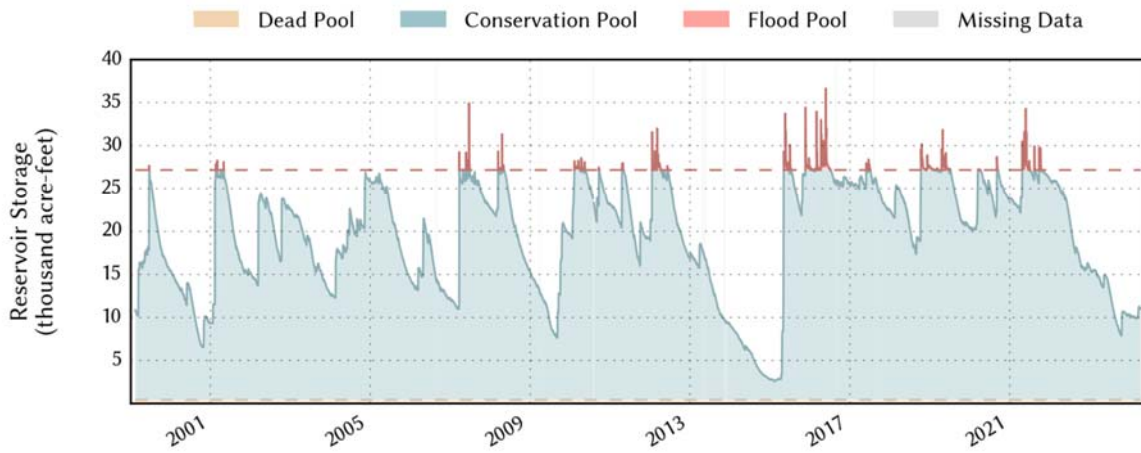

Lake Palo Pinto: 39.4% full as of 2024-04-19



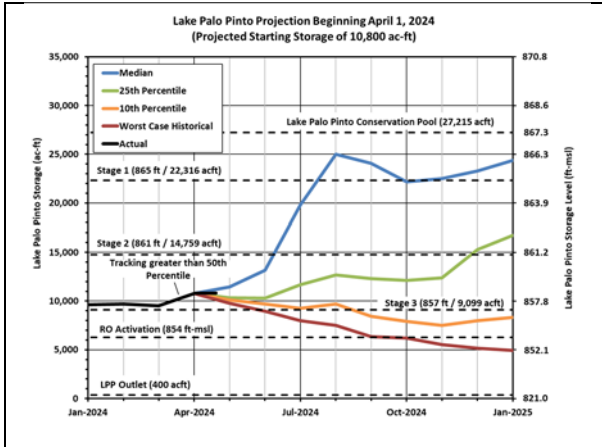
**CONSUMPTION DEMAND:** Consumption demand was unchanged (0.1%) when compared to last week. No major leaks, significant losses or extended service interruptions were reported this period. HWTP production for this week averaged 2.44 MGD.

**WEATHER FORECAST:** The 7-day outlook calls for rain to move into the watershed tonight (Friday) through much of the day on Saturday with 1” to 2” of accumulation possible.

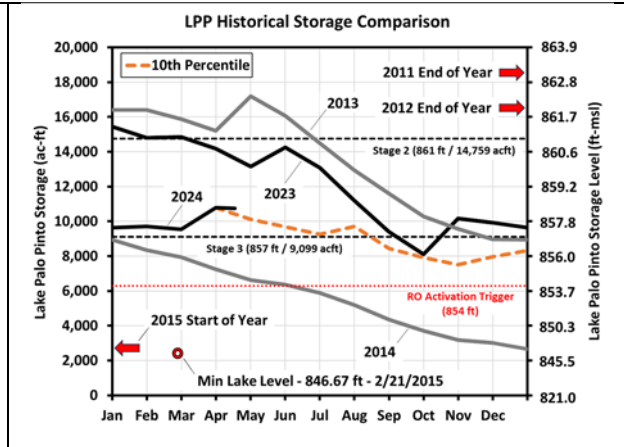
**SITUATION REPORT:** The lake level fell (0.12’ MSL) when compared to last period. Pre-Sed (-2.9”) and the Diversion Pool (-1” @ full pool) remain at operational levels. The release valve at Lake Palo Pinto was opened (4cfs) this period and the 1 blending pump (0.9MGD) @ Brazos is running.

Reminder: Stage II restrictions require a 25% reduction in consumption.

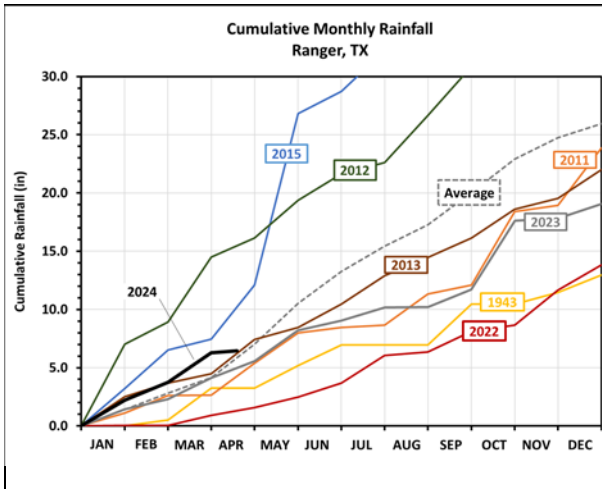
### Lake Palo Pinto Projections
